



SQUASH COURT RULES

1. Squash court membership fees will be determined by the Board of Directors from time to time. The prevailing membership fee can be obtained from the Estate Manager
2. The member who accessed the court will be held responsible for any damage caused by their guests or themselves. Any damage caused by the previous players must immediately be reported to the Estate Manager, or Security if after hours, before commencement of the game to avoid a penalty.
3. Playing time: 04:15am to 22:00pm daily
4. Only Rietvlei Heights Estate residents who are members of the Squash Club and whose fees are up to date are eligible to book the court.
5. Bookings must be made in person and will be accepted on a first-come-first-served basis. Bookings must be made in the Register held at the Security Gatehouse.
6. Each residential stand or unit is entitled to a maximum of 2 advanced bookings per week.
7. Advance bookings are permitted for up to seven (7) days, inclusive of the day booking.
8. No children under the age of 14 years are allowed to play without adult supervision.

9. The following General Court Rules are to be observed:

- a) No smoking / food / drinks are allowed in or on the court.
- b) Only shoes with non marking soles may be used on the court.
- c) Players must be properly attired in shorts and t-shirts.
- d) No other games except squash are allowed on the court.
- e) No pets are allowed in the playing area.

10. Court Access

- a) A key for entrance at the front door to the clubhouse and court must be collected and signed for in the Register at the Security Gatehouse.
- b) Two keys will be available at the Gatehouse and therefore each session will sign for a key and hand it back to the Security Officer at the Gatehouse.
- c) After completion of the game lock the court as well as the clubhouse and return the key to the Gatehouse and let the Security Officer sign for it in the register.
- d) On return of the key to the Gatehouse report any damage, should there be any, in writing in the register. Should the member fail to do so, the member will be liable for the cost of repairs.

11. The booking will automatically be forfeited after 10 (ten) minutes grace. The court will then be allocated to the next member on a first-come-first-served basis.

12. Players must give at least 24 hours notice for cancellation of any bookings. Failing to do so will be deemed as an advance booking session that has been utilized.

13. Members who fail to turn up after two bookings without having made proper cancellations will be barred from advance bookings of the court during the next four weeks.

14. Only two (2) people are permitted in the playing area at any time.

15. Competitions and/or friendly matches with other estates or groups must be approved by the Management with a notice period of at least one (1) month.

16. A Squash Court Committee will be elected by the Club Members and will comprise 3 Club Members and 1 Director of the HOA. The Committee will be responsible for amending the Rules as they deem necessary and any such amendments must be submitted to the Board of Directors for approval.
